

## DIGIFUSE - Fusing Innovation and Inclusion in Prison Education

As digital transformation reshapes education across Europe, the DIGIFUSE project seeks to ensure that prison education is not left behind.

Funded through the Erasmus+ programme and coordinated by CLICK F1 (Netherlands), DIGIFUSE - Digital Transition in Prison Education -brings together organisations from the Netherlands, Portugal, France, Belgium, Italy, Turkey, and EPEA to promote inclusive, digitally enhanced learning opportunities for incarcerated individuals.

DIGIFUSE addresses a pressing issue: while society becomes increasingly digital, many prison systems still face significant limitations in accessing and implementing digital education. The project aims to support national prison education systems in embracing this transition by offering structured tools, research insights, and collaborative strategies. It recognises the importance of not only digital access, but also the pedagogical and organisational frameworks that enable technology to serve learning and rehabilitation goals.

Currently, the project is developing its Work Package 2, which focuses on mapping current practices and needs through desk and field research. This stage is being developed using a S.O.I.T. analysis (Strategic, Organisational, Informational, and Technical), a strategic approach that helps partners identify both systemic challenges and emerging possibilities across participating countries. The research will combine academic and institutional data with insights from practitioners in the field.
